

BEE ANGLIA CASE STUDY



BACKGROUND:

Barnwell Print Ltd was established in 1840 and is the oldest family run printing company in the UK. They use traditional values with a modern approach.

ACTIONS:

A measure of upgrading current fluorescent lighting tubes to LEDs was suggested as this can lead to significant savings of £1,002 a year and 6.1tCO₂e.



Barnwell Print Ltd expressed interest in installing solar panels to the roof of their premises which is estimated to save 27,000kWh/year (£4780 and 15.5tCO₂e), based on an installation of a 30kWp system.

Since receiving the BEE Anglia report Barnwell Print have been awarded a Gold Level Carbon Charter. This recognises their excellent carbon reduction measures and helps the business to stand out from the crowd.
