THE PROJECT:

The Brook Inn in Copdock & Washbrook is a community-owned free house bought predominantly by local shareholders in 2014. They have recently been awarded grant funding from the Business Energy Efficiency (BEE) Anglia project for cavity wall and roof insulation plus window and door double-glazing.



Following an independent energy audit, The Brook Inn successfully applied for a grant of £2,500. The energy savings gained by implementing this project will amount to 9 tonnes of CO₂e per year, plus cost savings of £1,700. This will support future growth within their business, while working to protect our environment in line with their environmental policy.
